### QUALIFICATION OF ELECTORS

A person is entitled to be an elector at an election in a local municipality if, on Voting Day, he or she is a Canadian Citizen, is at least 18 years old, and resides in the local municipality, or is the owner or tenant of land in the local municipality, or the spouse of such a person, and is not prohibited from voting by the Municipal Elections Act, or any other Act. All electors at a voting place must show proof of name and qualifying address before receiving a ballot.

### PROXY APPLICATIONS

A person who is unable to attend the voting place may appoint another person as a voting proxy to attend a voting place and vote on their behalf. The person acting as a proxy must also be an eligible elector. A person who has been appointed a voting proxy may apply to the Clerk no later than 5 pm on October 24<sup>th</sup>, 2022, to receive a certificate to vote by proxy. **Proxy forms are available at Town Hall, 253 Main Street, Iroquois Falls, during business hours. Proxy forms will also be available at each voting location.**
