LANDFILL ACCESS FEES

Residential or commercial municipal property owner or tenant:

- New or replacement Landfill Access Card.....\$15.00 /calendar year
- Renewal Sticker (card required).....\$10.00/calendar year

Seasonal (non-commercial) tenant of a recognized campground
within the municipality.....\$10.00/season

Temporary (non-commercial) individual providing a service to
a municipal property owner or tenant.....\$10.00/week

Residential non-municipal property owner or tenant.....\$120/calendar year

Commercial non-municipal property owner providing a service to
a municipal property owner or tenant.....\$250.00/calendar year

TIPPING FEES

Appliances

Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners and dehumidifiers
(unless officially tagged).....~~\$40.00/unit~~ No Charge

Brush, Construction, and Demolition Waste

Pick-up truck, trailer or equivalent:

- Municipal resident.....~~\$10.00/unit~~ No Charge
- Non-municipal resident.....~~20.00/unit~~ No Charge

Single axle truck up to 5 tons, tandem trailer or equivalent:

- Municipal resident.....~~\$85.00/unit~~ No Charge
- Non-municipal resident.....~~\$100.00/unit~~ No Charge

Tandem axle dump truck including roll-off trailer or equivalent – 21 cubic yards or less:

- Municipal resident.....\$115.00/unit
- Non-municipal resident.....\$135.00/unit

Tri-axle dump truck including roll off trailer or equivalent – 21 cubic yards or more:

- Municipal resident.....\$175.00/unit
- Non-municipal resident.....\$200.00/unit

Household Waste

- In approved containers or bags.....No charge

Contaminated Materials Within Municipality - per Tandem or Tri-Axle Dump Truck

- Municipal resident.....\$250.00/unit
- Non-municipal resident.....\$500.00/unit

Accepted Recyclable Materials that are disposed of in designated recycling bins

Aerosol cans (empty)
Aluminum cans, trays, burner liners, pie plates and roasting pans
Boxboard boxes
Cardboard cans
Corrugated cardboard
Foam polystyrene (Styrofoam) - white only
Gift wrap, cards
Glass bottles and jars
Metal cans
Metal paint cans and lids (empty)
Milk/juice cartons and boxes
Newspapers, flyers, telephone directories, magazines, catalogues, soft/hardcover books
Paper bags, rolls, junk mail, writing/computer paper, envelopes, window envelopes
<u>Plastic - No. 1 to 7:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clamshell containers (hinged, clear plastic containers) • Clear fruit, vegetable, and take-out containers • Clear molded bakery item trays, egg cartons • Disposable plastic plates and glasses • Cold beverage cups/lids • Plastic bottles and jugs (lids on) • Plastic kitty litter tubs with plastic handles • Plastic laundry detergent tubs and lids • Clear compact disk cases (empty)
Plastic bags - grocery, shopping, dry cleaning, bread bags, vegetable/fruit bags, milk bags (outer and rinsed inner bag) - <i>Place all bags in one bag and tie handles together.</i>
Plastic outer wrap from packages, such as from paper towels, cases of water, etc...
Shredded paper - <i>Place in clear plastic bag and tie closed</i>

Scrap Metal

.....No Fee

Tires With Rims

Passenger tire up to 17".....\$8.00/tire No Charge

Passenger tire 17" to 23".....\$15.00/tire No Charge

All other tires.....\$40.00/tire

Tires Without Rims

Maximum of four tires per day.....No Fee

Tires in excess of four tire daily maximum.....\$5.00/tire No Charge
