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DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY

I, Mayor Tory Delaurier hereby declare an Emergency, due to unprecedented high-water levels at Nellie Lake, in accordance with the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act, s.4.(1) due to the emergency described herein:

The Town of Iroquois Falls is now faced with potentially significant danger due in part, but not limited to the following concerns:

- The contamination of sewage due to flooded septic systems on Nellie Lake.
- The threat to potable water due to contamination.
- Concerns for the safety and well being of volunteers assisting with the flooding.
- Concerns with the ability of the municipality to deliver services to Nellie Lake residents should flooding persist.
- Threats to tourism businesses that thrive on the natural beauty of the Nellie Lake area.
